Uniform Expectations



- A smart appearance amongst students enhances their image and that of their school, instils a more business-like and purposeful mood and avoids competition over fashions and 'labels'. Students should fully observe the school's requirements about personal appearance throughout the school year. All items should be named so we can return lost property to their owners.
- **ALL** students in Years 7 – 11 are expected to wear school uniform in school, on journeys to and from school, at school functions (including Consultation Evenings) and on visits where school uniform is required.



General information about school uniform

- All clothing and sports kit should be clearly named.
- No hoodies allowed in school. An outdoor coat may be worn over the top of a blazer
- We strongly recommend that students cycling to school wear fluorescent jackets and a safety cycle helmet
- Make up is not allowed, other than very subtle application. Nail varnish and acrylic or gel nails are not allowed
- Hair styles should be of natural colour; exaggerated styles and ‘tram lines’ are not acceptable
- Jewellery for health and safety reasons, should be kept at a minimum. Wristwatch, one small set of earrings or sleepers in the ears are allowed. No alternative piercings are acceptable. Bracelets, bangles rings and other jewellery items are to be left at home
- Medical alert tags where required, must be worn at all times



Blazer	Black with school badge – must be worn to and from school and throughout the school day.
Shirt/Blouse	Plain white (not patterned) with a stiffened collar, top button and capable of taking a tie (polo shirts or fashion blouses are not acceptable).
Tie	School tie which is available from school only.
Jumper (optional)	A plain black ‘V’ neck jumper with full length sleeves may be worn under the blazer for additional warmth. This is optional. It may not replace the blazer.
Skirt	Grey, tailored, plain or pleated; knee-length. No ‘tube’, elastic or tight-fitting skirts. Wolstanton High School official grey school skirts are available from school suppliers but are not compulsory.
Trousers	Tailored, grey with waistband and zip. The trousers must be of normal length, without belt or decorations. Tight fitting, low cut, jeans or ‘jean style’ trousers are not acceptable.
Footwear	Black low heeled, enclosed at the heel and toe. Shoes must be able to be polished. No boots, trainers, canvas pumps or logos.
Socks / tights	Black, grey or white socks; black or neutral-coloured tights.
Outdoor Wear	An outdoor coat to be worn in cold, wet weather over the blazer, and removed when in school buildings. Zip up cardigans/sweatshirts with/without hoods are not acceptable as outdoor wear.

Religious headwear must be plain black or plain white.

Wolstanton High School – Guidance on School Footwear

Black low heeled, enclosed at the heel and toe. **Shoes must be able to be polished. No boots, trainers, canvas pumps or logos.**

PE kit

P.E. KIT (Boys/Girls)

- **Indoors**
- House-colours polo shirt (plain or with a school badge)
- House-colours shorts or black sports leggings
- Games socks.
- Training shoes.

Outdoors (additional to above)

- Black track suit bottoms.
- House-colours hooded jumper or plain black hooded sweatshirt (optional).
- Football boots (when required).
- Waterproof jacket (optional).

Safety Equipment (compulsory - students will be notified by their teacher when required): shin pads, mouth guard.

All students are expected to have the following basic equipment for lessons in a school appropriate bag:





Phones and technological wrist devices are not allowed to be used in school . Please note, if students are seen with headphones or speakers then it will be assumed they are using their phone.

Students are to ensure that they are left in bags and switched off at all times

Non compliance with the school uniform expectations

The wearing of school uniform is one of the basic expectations of our students. In the event of any student arriving at school without the correct uniform, we will contact parents/carers to request that the correct item is brought into school or where this is not possible, we will seek consent from the parents/ carers to send the student home in order to address the issue.

If inappropriate footwear is worn then pupils will be given school black pumps to wear for the day.

If unable to correct the issue of inappropriate uniform then students will not be allowed in normal circulation for the day. They will be in isolation for each day completing work set by their teachers until the uniform issue is resolved.

If a student is seen with their mobile phone or accessories (headphones, speakers etc) the equipment will be removed and locked in a safe until parents' /carers can collect at the end of the day and an after school detention will be issued.
